## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Apply masking tape 1 " from the rim of the glass. Pull the tape taught as you wrap it around. Only the TOP edge of the tape needs to be straight and smooth, the bottom can wrinkle.
2. Apply masking tape about halfway down the stem. Pull the tape taught as you wrap it around. Only the BOTTOM edge of the tape needs to be straight and smooth, the top can wrinkle.
3. Paint 2 coats of Banana Boat to the top of the glass (above the tape) using a medium brush.
4. Paint 2 coats of Banana Boat to the foot of the glass up the stem to the bottom of the tape.
5. Use a fan brush to paint the inside of the glasses with 3 coats of Honeycomb.
6. Next, we are going to apply the dots to both the yellow sections. Dip the handle end of the detail brush into Honeycomb and apply a few dots. Continue all over.
7. Repeat step 6 using Banana Boat and then Lemon Mist. Allowing the dots to overlap.
8. If needed, repeat step 6 \& 7 until you have the desired amount of dots.
9. Now we are going to remove the paint. If your paint has completely dried, it will crumble on the edge when removed. To avoid that, use a medium brush dipped in water and pat along the edge of the tape to dampen the paint. Peel off tape.
10. Paint the section between the to yellow sections with 3 coats of Licorice. Use a liner brush where the black will meet the yellow to help get a smoother line.
11. When the Licorice is dry use the NCR pattern to trace the words onto the side of the glass.
12. Use a detail brush to apply 3 coats of London Fog to the printed words.
13. Finally, use a liner brush to apply 3 coats of Honeycomb to the scripted words.

## TIPS

- 3 coats of paint will give you an even solid color.
- Allow the dots to overlap.
